



Hi!

There will be a rose-themed quilt display at the Fall 2010 American Rose Society Conference & Rose Show in Marietta (Atlanta), GA, October 7-10, 2010. It won't be a judged show, just a display, but we'd love to have the opportunity to share your beautiful quilts with conference attendees.

Since it's not a judged show, we don't have a lot of rules.

- ✚ Let us know that you will be showing a quilt no later than September 15, so we can be sure to have room/equipment to display them. We will need to know the size of the quilt at that time.
- ✚ Quilts can be any size, from miniature on up. Quilted wearable objects are also welcome. Quilts should be hand or machine quilted, not tied.
- ✚ A rose or roses should be the primary theme and/or rose-patterned fabric should predominate.
- ✚ Please send a photo of your quilt so we can keep track of it!
- ✚ Quilts must have a label firmly attached on the back right-hand corner. They must also have a sleeve attached to the back at the top, for display purposes.
- ✚ You are responsible for getting quilts *to and from* the show. Quilts should arrive at the show no later than 9am on Friday, October 8. They will be hung that day, and displayed through Sunday, October 10. You may mail or hand-deliver the quilts to the show. If you will not be present to pick up your quilt at the end of the show, please send a written authorization so that we can release the quilt to your representative at the end of the show.
- ✚ You do not have to be registered for the convention to show a quilt (but you'll be missing a good time if you aren't).
- ✚ You do not have to be a member of the American Rose Society to show a quilt (but we'd love it if you were!).
- ✚ Quilts may be donated to the ARS to be sold at a silent auction during the conference. The American Rose Society is a 501-c-3 organization, so the value of donated quilts qualifies as a tax deduction. We hope you will consider donating your quilt to the ARS. 100% of the money raised will go to the ARS.
- ✚ The public will be able to visit the quilt display and rose show at no cost on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. There will be a registration fee for those attending lectures or participating in other convention activities.

Please share this with your rosy/quilting friends, and let us know you'll be coming!
